STATEMENT OF COOPERATION 2003-2004 School Year

1. We have read the doctrinal statement of Grandview Park Baptist School. We understand and agree that our child(ren) will be taught these Biblical truths while enrolled in Grandview Park Baptist School.

2. In making application for my child, it is my desire to have him complete the 2003-2004 school year. It is also my understanding that the policy of the school is to make no refunds on registration fees. I also give permission for my child to take part in all school activities, including sports and school-sponsored trips away from the school premises, and absolve the school from liability to me or my child because of any injury to my child at school or during any school activity.

3. We agree that if our child should become involved in any difficulty with other children in the school or with any school personnel, we will support the actions of the teachers and administrators. We agree to follow the Biblical principles of confrontation based on Matthew 18:15-17.

4. We agree to support the rules and regulations set forth by the school, and we will support and uphold the principles, practices, and educational policies of the school in every way.

5. We understand that the school reserves the right to dismiss any student who does not cooperate with the educational process, and that all students are accepted on a probationary basis.

6. We agree that the administration has full responsibility for placing my child in the proper grade. However, GPBS makes no expressed guarantee of re-admission in subsequent years.

7. We agree that this application covers one school year only. Its acceptance is left totally to the discretion of GPBS and is no guarantee of re-admission in subsequent years.

8. We agree to pay our financial obligation to the school on or before the first school day of the month, and realize that a **\$20.00 late charge** will be assessed if payment is not received by the **10th of the month**. Refunds: Registration Fee: **Non-refundable**. Refunds for activity fee will be as follows:

If for any reason your child(ren) is/are withdrawn during the school year, the current month's charges are due and will not be refunded. For example, if a student attends school throughout the 9th of October, the entire month's tuition is due.

9. We understand that if our tuition obligation is one month in arrears that if we have not made payment or financial arrangements, our child(ren) will not be allowed to attend school during the month following the month of delinquency. If financial arrangements have not been made by the 10th of that month, the student(s) may not be considered for re-enrollment. Absence as a result of the above named reasons will be considered unexcused.

10. We also understand that if for any reason our child(ren) is/are withdrawn during the school year, the current month's charges are due and will not be refunded.

Grandview Park Baptist Ministries *DOCTRINAL STATEMENT

- 1. We believe in the Scriptures of the Old and New Testaments as inspired by God and inerrant in the original writings. We believe that they are the supreme and final authority in faith and life.
- 2. We believe in the Triune God, and that the three Persons of the Godhead – Father, Son, and Holy Spirit – are co-equal and co-eternal and thus one True God.
- 3. We believe Jesus Christ was both God and man, begotten by the Holy Spirit and born of a virgin.
- 4. We believe in God the Holy Spirit:
 - a. His personality;
 - b. His advent – past, present, and future;
 - c. His ministry – restraining, regenerating, indwelling all believers, baptizing, sealing, and filling.
- 5. We believe that Satan was created holy but fell and drew a host of angels after him. He is now the corrupting prince and unholy god of this world.
- 6. We believe in the Genesis account of creation in six days, accepted literally and wholly apart from any evolutionary process.
- 7. We believe that man was the direct creation of God, made in His image; however, by voluntary transgression, man fell. We believe that the consequence of this is that all mankind are sinners and are under just condemnation, without defense or excuse.
- 8. We believe that salvation of sinners is through the voluntary, substitutionary death of Jesus Christ, the sinless Son of God, bearing our sins in His own body.
We believe that faith in the Lord Jesus Christ is the only condition of salvation and that repentance is a change of mind and purpose toward God, prompted by the Holy Spirit.
- 9. We believe in the resurrection of the crucified body of the crucified Lord, in His ascension into heaven, and in His ministry for us as High Priest and Advocate.
- 10. We believe that in order to be saved, sinners must be born again. We believe that the new birth is instantaneous and not a process.
- 11. We believe that all who are truly born again are eternally kept by God the Father.
- 12. We believe in the unity of all true believers in the Church which was established on the Day of Pentecost. We believe that all believers are added to the Church by the baptism of the Holy Spirit.
- 13. We believe that the universal Church is manifested through the local church which is a congregation of immersed believers.
- 14. We believe that Christian baptism is the believer’s single immersion in water, in the name of the Father, Son, and Holy Spirit. We believe that baptism precedes church membership and is a public recognition of the Lordship of Jesus Christ.
- 15. We believe that the Lord’s Supper is a memorial service and symbolizes in a sacred manner the death of our Lord Jesus Christ on our behalf. We believe that participants in the service should include immersed believers only.
- 16. We believe in “that Blessed Hope,” the personal, pre-millennial, and imminent return of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ for His Church.

- 17. We believe that the rapture of the Church saints will be followed by a seven-year period called the Tribulation.
- 18. We believe that Christ will return to the Earth and establish His kingdom of peace on Earth for a thousand years (the Millennium).
- 19. We believe in personal holiness of life. We believe that we are to be conformed to the image of Jesus Christ – not to the world.
- 20. We believe in the bodily resurrection of the just and of the unjust, in the everlasting felicity of the saved, and in the everlasting, conscious suffering of the lost.
- 21. We believe that civil government is of divine appointment for the interest and good order of human society.
- 22. We believe that God is the originator of the marriage relationship. We believe that marriage between a man and a woman is designed by God to be a picture of the relationship between Jesus Christ and the Church. We believe that marriage is a permanent relationship, broken only by death.
